



How to Check In “Good Standing” for Coaches

In “Good Standing” means that a coach is current in the following requirements as mandated by Skate Canada:

Clubs can go to the Skate Canada Membership site to access current “Good Standing” status of any Skate Canada coach. Once signed into the membership site the information can be found under the Coach Eligibility tab. Enter the name of the coach in the search tool. Pick their name from the list to see their current status.

A “YES” answer appears when all of the categories above have been met.

A “NO” will appear if any of the above categories are not current or have not been met. This means that the coach is NOT eligible to coach in any capacity until their in “Good Standing” appears as a YES. It is the responsibility of the coach to ensure that they remain up to date throughout the season.

NCCP Certification & The Locker

In order to coach certain programs, a coach must have met a minimum certification requirement in their NCCP.

Anyone can look up a coach’s NCCP status and Maintenance of Certification on The Locker

<https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login> You will need their last name and their NCCP number to search. The NCCP number can be found on the Skate Canada Membership site where you view the coach in “Good Standing” page.

Note: If the required point total for the maintenance of certification for the current cycle has not been met, their NCCP status will read “not active” and the coach will not be eligible to coach in any capacity until resolved.

What should you do if you find a coach is not in good standing? Notify the coach immediately! Only the coach will be able to see on their profile which criteria is not current. They will not be able to coach until their status has changed to YES. It is the coaches responsibility to ensure they maintain their in good standing status, but we recommend that clubs take note of all coaches unique expiry date.
