Requirements To Apply: *

Applicants must have the following:

- be in good standing with Skate Canada and maintain an up to date membership as a professional coach
- provide proof of certification level
- proof of Star 1-5 assessment training
- valid first aid certificate
- proof of completing the Respect in Sport Program
- proof of completing the Making Ethical Decisions course

An up to date criminal record check and child abuse registry check is also required (at coach's cost)

Applicants must also have Regional Coach/in-training Certification

Roles & Responsibilities of selected coach: *

Must be able to provide coaching to on ice groups and off ice groups.

Must be willing to attend board meetings for the purpose of planning and enhancing programs.

Must be willing to be involved in planning and showcasing the Star Skaters in our annual ice show.

Be able to attend competitions and assist with choreography

Be able to communicate to parents about upcoming, events, seminars, competitions, etc.

Have the ability to teach all levels and disciplines up to and including gold level

Skills: Have strong communication skills and interpersonal skills with skaters, parents, and board members.

The successful candidate will possess the following skills: * The coach will also need to be well organized and self motivated when planning and completing formal evaluations throughout the season.
